Problem Animal Control Permit

Is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of Section 4, Chapter 131 of the Massachusetts General Laws and Code of Massachusetts Regulations 321 CMR 2.14 to harass, take and destroy or may release or liberate as stipulated in 321 CMR 2.14 (23) by legal means, with the consent of the owner or tenant, the following species or group of species causing damage or problems to private or public property:

Snapping turtle, Starling, Pigeon, House (English) sparrow, Opossum, Moles, Bats except those species listed in 321 CMR 10.90, Cottontail rabbits, European rabbits, Chipmunk, Gray, Red and, Flying squirrels, Woodchuck, Muskrat, Rats, Mice, and Voles except those species listed in 321 CMR 10.90, Porcupine, Raccoon, Weasels, Red and Gray foxes, and Skunk.

Problem animals taken alive under authority of this permit shall be disposed of by destruction in a humane manner, by immediate liberation at the site of capture or by transferal to a licensed wildlife rehabilitator in the case of a sick or injured animal.

No problem animals or parts thereof (except those taken during the regulated open season and in compliance with any and all rules and regulations set for the species involved) taken under authority of this permit may be retained, sold, bartered or otherwise disposed of, except as provided in this permit, without specific authorization from this office.

This permit must be in the possession of the permittee at all times while engaged in the activities described herein. The permittee must carry at all times, a Massachusetts hunting, sporting or trapping license (and a currently valid trap registration certificate). All traps must be tagged and numbered in accordance with provisions of law.

A written report shall be sent to this office upon expiration of this permit, no later than January 31, stating the total number of complaints, the species involved, the number of animals taken, destroyed or surrendered, the disposition of same and any other information as the Director may require.

Permittees shall adhere to all provisions of 321 CMR 2.14 unless special authorization or exemption is given.
